HAWKESBURY FAMILY HISTORY GROUP

The Hawkesbury Family History Group was formed in August 1982 due to the popularity of family history. Numerous researchers were using the library facilities & the group was established following a get together in the Library. The Hawkesbury Family History Group is basically a support & information group for family historians & is co-ordinated by the Local Studies Librarian of Hawkesbury City Library. Guest speakers feature at each meeting, talking on a variety of topics, relating to family & local history. Attendance at meetings range from 20-50, with some people travelling long distances to attend.

FACILITIES

The Hawkesbury Family History Group does not have its own research library. The Group regularly donates research tools such as indexes, books, CD-ROMs etc to the Library's Local Studies Collection.

RESEARCH

The Group does not undertake research on behalf of others. The Library offers a basic Research Service which is **fee** basis, on material that is unique to the collection & only available to people living unreasonable distances from the library, making a personal visit impossible. LOCAL STUDIES COLLECTION

The Local Studies Collection of Hawkesbury Library has an excellent collection of material relating to family & local history research. The Local Studies Collection is free and accessible to all members of the public, however items are not available for loan. The types of material kept in the Local Studies Collection include: Books (family histories, local history, how-to-genealogy) ~ Church, Cemetery & Census Records ~ Electoral Rolls & PO Directories ~ Newspapers, Photographs & Maps ~ Microfiche/film & Electronic Resources ~ Newsletters & journals. The Library also has a subscription to various online databases including Ancestry Library.
