As part of the G.I. application a copy of the Association's Certificate of Incorporation is required. Unfortunately was unable to locate the certificate in any of the paperwork or in the possession of any of the current members – hence sort approval from the committee to obtain a duplicate copy from the Department of Fair Trading. Copy was obtained on 14/08/02 and cost the Association \$13.00. Receipt tabled for which reimbursement has already been made.

With the submission for G.I. the application must be accompanied by two sets of maps – one set must have the G.I. boundary marked and the other must be unmarked. Even though this represents some 60 odd maps and the application has described the boundary in detail, it is a requirement of submission.

GENERAL BUSINESS

2002 Bud Burst Festival

Peter Auld gave a quick overview of the 2002 Bud Burst Festival – last years single day event has been extended to a two week period (14th to 29th September).

Focus is on the main day at Vicary's Winery on the 15th with most of the cellar door wineries attending and showcasing their wines. Event will be run from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm with a luncheon (including regional wines) being held at 1:00 pm.

Camden is also holding a Food & Wine Festival over the same time period in conjunction with the Bud Burst Festival. Also included in this is Jazz in the Vineyard at Kirkham Estate.

Tizzana Winery is having several events – Art Burst in the Vineyard (an art show in the cellars) that is running the length of the festival. Also holding a Jazz day on the 29th in conjunction with the Hawkesbury Jazz Club.

Vicary's Winery will also be hosting the National Petanque Championship's on the 29th. It is hoped that this will become an annual event as part of the festival.

The Independent will be running an article on the festival in its upcoming issue. Release date is the first week of September.

Regional Mixed Dozen

Geoff Skurray asked about the regional mixed dozen. Still looking at the licensing issues as it appears that only Tizzana Winery and Vicary's Winery may be the only outlets that could sell the dozen packs. All of the remaining cellar doors have Vignerons Licenses that only allow for the sale of estate made wines. Further clarification is needed.

Regional Status

The application for regional status was tabled at the meeting. Some sections need some minor reworking to meet the requirements, but the document tabled is effectively the application that will be submitted.

Geoff Skurray congratulated Jonathan Auld on behalf of the group for all of the work put into the application to date.

Moved that the regional application as tabled be approved in principle by the association in order to be submitted to the Geographical Indications Committee at the Australian Wine & Brandy Corporation for regional status. Moved: Jonathan Auld
