- From the left column of the chart - find the 1<sup>st</sup> person's relationship to the common ancestor.
- From the top row of the chart - locate the 2<sup>nd</sup> person's relationship to the common ancestor.
- Then follow across the row and down the column until you meet in one box which shows the relationship.
- 'Removed' means that the persons are not of the same generation
