With little trace of the female factory women's voices, the six historic moments, known as factory riots speak volumes about life in the Parramatta Female Factory - corruption, mismanagement and the women's fight for better conditions from the 1820s to the 1840s. This is a reminder that Hawkesbury Library Service has a subscription for Find My Past. This is a very useful family history database with a wide variety of records from the UK, Australia/NZ as well as other places.

#### Records include:

- UK Parish records (church baptism, marriage & burial records)
- UK Census records 1841–1911 (not the 1921 census)
- NSW wills 1800-1982
- Immigration and passenger lists



- Australian content like convict records, electoral rolls etc
- British Newspapers

It is only available to access while you are physically in the Library (Windsor or Richmond) and it is free to use. public PCs. It is accessible via your own device (laptop, tablet, phone) and we have free wifi.
